2019 Vendor Rules and Regulations

- Grill Wars is being held at **Bayfront Festival Park** on **Wednesday August 14, 2019**
- You may start setting up at 10:00 am - enter through the usual vendor set-up entrance at the west end of the Bayfront parking lot
- You will be assigned an area before set up begins
- Grill Wars is open to the public for 3 hours – **5:00 to 8:00 pm**
- Burgers cannot be served until 5:00 pm
- You must provide a copy of your commercial kitchen license on the day of the event
- You are required to have a tent and must bring your own grill and tent or awning to cover the grill. The grill must be clean
- Everyone will be provided with a 10 X 10 foot space – it will be marked with the name of your restaurant (tents larger than 10 X 10 will be allowed, space permitting)
- Please respect your fellow grillers and unload quickly
- Midwest Communications, The DECC, Bayfront Park and the City of Duluth and all participating sponsors are not responsible for unattended tents or lost or stolen items
- All burgers must be prepared and cooked on site to at least 155 degrees – the Minnesota Department of Health may show up to inspect your booth area for cleanliness and to check the meat temperature
- All burgers must be cut into fourths and served (mini-burgers are allowed as long as they are the same size as a fourth of a burger)
- All hands must be covered in plastic and hairnets must be worn for anyone with hair shoulder length or longer
- Please have enough people helping you to grill, serve, cut and clean your work area
- Expect to serve about 3,000 people (approximately 200 lbs. of meat)
- You must provide your own plates and napkins
- There will be hand washing stations at the event for you to wash hands while you are cooking
- There will be 20 satellite toilets
- All cooking materials and tools must be clean and sterile
- No cloth towels may be used to dry anything that is being served to the public
- You are responsible for the following: Hand Sanitizer (must be visible), Tent, Prep table(s), Gloves, Grill, Bleach, Cooler, Ice, Apron, Utensils, Hairnet, Spices and Condiments (ketchup, mustard, etc.)
- We encourage you to bring your own signage with the name of your restaurant and burger on it to hang at your booth – people will remember to vote for your burger if they can remember what it's called and associate it with your restaurant
- Please clean up your area and pack up your tent, grill, etc. Please clean up, throw away garbage around your own area and pack up quickly and be respectful of your fellow grillers
- Please bring your own garbage cans and bags at your booth to ease clean up
- A \$1,000 prize will be awarded to the winning burger/restaurant
- Trophies will be awarded to the top three restaurants
- Judging will be done by the public
- Votes will be tallied by the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Northland staff
